
THE COURT NOW FINDS that pursuant to R.S.Mo. § 473.047, the purported Last Will and Testament of Kenneth C. Wehrman, deceased, dated February 12, 2003, is not the *bona fide* Will of decedent and;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the aforesaid instrument is and shall be rejected from probate as the Last Will and Testament of Kenneth C. Wehrman, Jr.

IT IS, FURTHER ORDERED that a true copy of this Certificate and Order be filed in Case No. 06JE-00056.




4. That the Will of Kenneth C. Wehrman, Jr., deceased, dated October 21, 1988, was properly executed by him and attested to by the subscribing witnesses.

5. That Kenneth C. Wehrman, Jr. is deceased and said Will was not revoked by him during his lifetime.


6. That the presumption that the purported Will of Kenneth C. Wehrman, Jr. dated February 12, 2003 (referred to in the Petition for Probate of Will and for Letters Testamentary as bearing a date of January 13, 2003), revoked the aforementioned Will of October 21, 1988, has been rebutted by evidence presented to this Court. The Court specifically finds the purported Will of February 12, 2003, to not be the *bona fide* Will of Kenneth C. Wehrman, Jr.

7. That the Certificate of Marriage purportedly issued by the State of Hawaii, and filed with this Court in Cause No. 06JE-0102, wherein decedent and Linda Wroblewski were purportedly married on January 3, 2003, is likewise found to be invalid and not a *bona fide* Certificate of Marriage; and that Kenneth C. Wehrman, Jr. died single and unmarried.

8. That the Petition for Probate of Will and for Letters Testamentary filed by Linda Wroblewski on June 14, 2006, bearing Case No. 06JE-0102, is being dismissed with prejudice pursuant to this Court's Certificate and Order Rejecting the Will dated February 12, 2003, filed contemporaneously herewith.



IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the aforementioned instrument in writing dated October 21, 1988, shall be admitted to probate as the Last Will and Testament of Kenneth C. Wehrman, Jr., deceased, and the same shall be recorded as required by law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Letters Testamentary issue pursuant to the Will dated October 21, 1988, to Donald Lorino as Independent Personal Representative in accordance with Sections 473.780 through 473.840 RSMo., 1978, as amended.
