SQL Queries: Clauses

- SELECT contains all the fields to return from the given tables in FROM
- FROM lists all the tables where the query will be pulling information from
- WHERE (optional) contains the conditional which will be checked for each record to decide whether or not to return the record
 - Use:
- ORDER BY (optional) contains the fields which the query will sort by when it returns the records
- Order matters the structure of a query goes like this: SELECT ... FROM ... WHERE ... ORDER
 BY. The query will be evaluated like this: FROM, WHERE, ORDER, SELECT
