STATUS

ACL2 continues to be actively developed.

- ► ACL2 Version 8.3 released April, 2020 68 release note items
- ► ACL2 Version 8.4 released August, 2021: 131 release note items
- ► ACL2 Version 8.5 released July, 2022:
 - 78 release note items
- ► ACL2 Version 8.6 released October, 2024:
 - 211 release note items
 - ► 41 of those were made since the preceding ACL2 Workshop in November 2023
- ► ACL2 Version 8.7 is under development.

Probably most ACL2 users get ACL2 and the community books from GitHub.

But we expect to continue with "releases".
