SQL Queries: Basic Form

```

```
SELECT <list of fields> FROM  [ WHERE <condition> ]
[ ORDER BY <list of fields> [ DESC ] ]
```

- WHERE select only records where this condition is true for the record
 The condition in the WHERE clause is evaluated <u>exactly once</u>
- **ORDER BY** sort the returned records by a number of fields (defaults to ascending. Sort by descending by adding a **DESC** at the end of the clause

BigQuery

- For public data, you can pin the project "bigquery-public-data" to your project
- To reference datasets in BigQuery's SQL from other projects, your **FROM** clause should look like this:

```
[...] FROM `<project>.<dataset>` [...]
```
