Disposition one disputed finding

10 min

- A PR doubles a probe budget. A reviewer says it can exceed the rack limit; the author replies that the harness caps total steps.
- Classify the finding: blocker, question, quality issue, taste, or reviewer error. Write the smallest evidence that would settle it.
- Draft the author's response and verdict, then compare with a pair that classified it differently.
- Deliverable: classification, settling evidence, response, and the disagreement that remains.
